Thank you for purchasing pBuzz. We hope you and your family have many hours of fun – that's why we created it! Here are a few tips to help get you started.

How to play

1. **Buzz:** Position the mouthpiece in the middle of your lips, create a hole in your lips and blow air through it. Slowly make the hole smaller as you blow to create a buzz - watch at: www.bit.ly/2y0Qlzy
2. **Slide:** The moveable slide has six notes or slide positions: 1 – 6 or F, G, A, B, Bb, C. See Chris talking about how to move the slide at <https://youtu.be/eKfbupivFBc>
3. **Making a note:** Slide the bell towards you to create a high note and away from you to create a low note

Cleaning

pBuzz is completely made from plastic, making it very durable and robust – which means it is safe to use and easy to clean.

To clean the external red surfaces, use a soft cloth with warm soapy water and dry the instrument with a lint free cloth. We recommend that you clean the instrument before first use, being careful not to get soapy water on the clear tube as this may damage the coloured paper insert.

We do not recommend placing or immersing the pBuzz fully in water as this can damage the coloured-paper insert sleeve inside the clear plastic tube. If you do need a replacement coloured-paper insert please email us info@pbuzz.co.uk

Mouthpiece

The pBuzz mouthpiece has an embedded anti-microbial from BioCote® which kills 99% of germs within 15 minutes. You can clean the pBuzz mouthpiece fully in warm soapy water and even put pBuzz mouthpieces in the dishwasher for cleaning!

If your mouthpiece is stuck, run the red part of the mouthpiece receiver under hot tap water to allow the outer to expand, taking care not to get the insert wet. Then carefully pull the mouthpiece out.

Disassembling the pBuzz or replacing the coloured paper insert

To disassemble the pBuzz follow these simple steps:

1. Remove the mouthpiece
2. Remove the black rubber washer – be careful not to let the middle pipe fall on the floor as you remove the washer
3. Carefully push the middle pipe through the bottom of the bell – you will now have 2 separate sections.
4. You can gently click upwards the top of the clear plastic cover to reveal the paper insert
5. To re-assemble pBuzz reverse steps 4 through 1

Storage

We recommend standing pBuzz vertically on its bell with the mouthpiece in the top. Be careful that the mouthpiece is not pushed too hard into the receiver.

Take care not to store pBuzz in locations such as:

- Locations exposed to direct sunlight;
- Close to naked flames from sources such as cooking stoves;
- Locations affected by flowing water or rain;
- Locations with high humidity; or
- Locations with high levels of dust or dirt

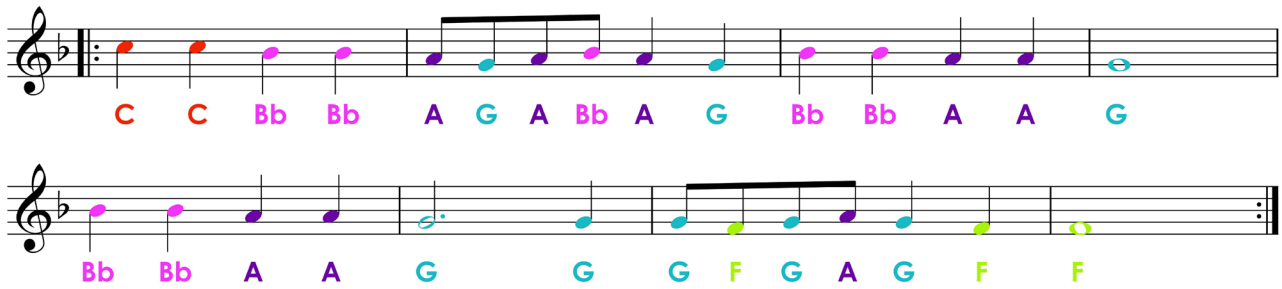

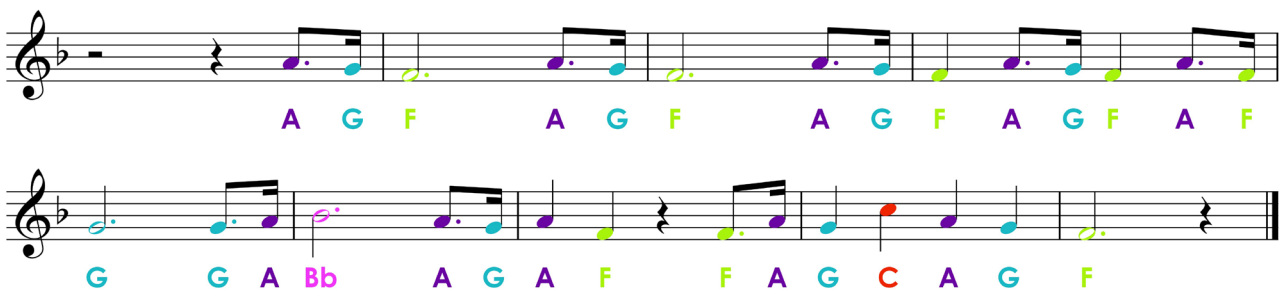

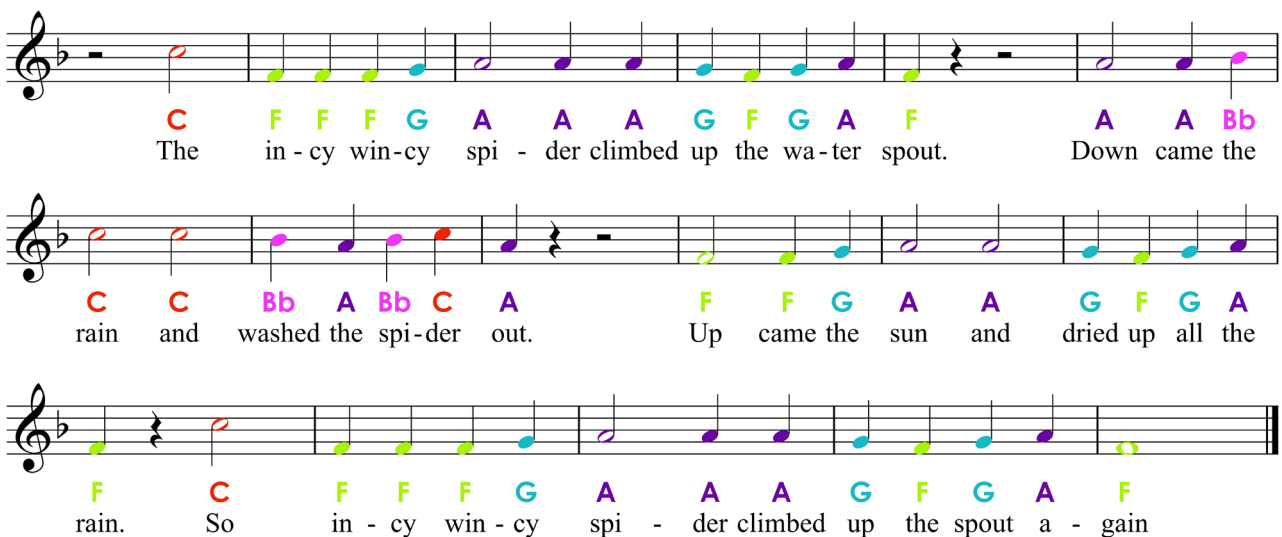
